During his Congressional career, Ose served on the Government Reform Committee, Agriculture Committee, and the Financial Services Committee. For his work in Congress, Ose was named a Hero of the Taxpayers by Americans for Tax Reform, a Guardian of Small Business by the National Federation of Independent Business, and honored by several other groups for his patriotism, integrity and devotion to public service. After leaving Congress, Ose returned to the family business and continues to serve his community. In 2011, he assumed operations of Gibson Ranch Regional Park as a public-private partnership. Once one of the most beautiful and popular public parks of the Sacramento County Regional Park System, Gibson Ranch had been closed and allowed to deteriorate due to a lack of funding. When Sacramento County needed a private operator, Ose was the only one willing to take on the challenge. After guiding Gibson Ranch's rebuilding and rejuvenation, public use of the park has increased dramatically to more than 100,000 visitors per year.

Doug is running to be your representative in Washington because he is concerned about what kind of country we are leaving our children and grandchildren. With record high unemployment, government takeover of our health care, increasing taxes and runaway spending, we are leaving the next generation with unprecedented debt and limited opportunity. Member of the House of Representatives serve two-year terms so every house seat is up for grabs in every election cycle. This means that California voters will have an opportunity to elect new members of Congress or reelect their present congressperson.

The current partisan make-up of the California House gives Democrats an advantage over Republicans 28 vs 15.

At the present time Republicans hold 234 seats in the House of Representatives and Democrats have 201. In order for Nancy Pelosi to regain the Speaker Chair in the (you remember her " But we Have to Pass [Obamacare] Bill So That You Can Find Out What Is In It") House of Representatives, Democrats will need to make a net gain of 17 seats.

In 2012, Democrats recovered somewhat from their 63 seat lost inflicted on them by voters in 2010 with a net gain of 8 seats. Four out of eight seats that the Democrats won in 2012 were in California. Rep. Dan Lungren from Sacramento County lost along with Brian Bilbray in San Diego and Mary Bono Mack from Palm Springs. And the seat held by retired Rep. Elton Gallegly for the last 26 years was also won by the Democrats. In 2014 Democrats will make a push to take over the seat of Rep. Gary Miller in the 31st District (San Bernardino County).

Political Experts that I know say with strong Republican candidates in the 7th, 36th and 52nd Districts. Republicans can make sure Pelosi says out of Speaker Chair in the House of Representatives.

With your help Republicans of River City will play a major role in retaking the 7th Congressional District seat for the Republican Party.
