

You start the appointment process by visiting the Sacramento County web site at http://www.sccob.saccounty.net or you write to the Board Clerk (or visit their office at Sacramento County Administration Center, 700 H Street, Suite 2450, Sacramento, CA 95814).

Review the 70 page document that lists all of the board and commission positions in county government. You can find out the responsibilities of each board or commission and even attend one or two of their meetings in order to make a decision on the one you would like to join.

Set up an appointment with your county supervisor and discuss your background and your interest in serving the community.

Then fill out an application to apply. I know if you are appointed you will do a great job and sometime in the future it may lead to serving on a state board or commission. Or better yet, your entry into elective office.



MS. CLINTON IN THE MEDIA

In the aftermath of Ms. Clinton's press conference this past Tuesday, attention to the story has continued to grow, a new HuffPost/YouGov poll finds. Sixty-five percent of Americans now say they're following the story at least somewhat closely, up from 53 percent in a survey last week. The percent of Americans who call the issue at least somewhat serious is also higher going from 47 percent to 54 percent.

The spread between Republicans' and Democrats' has grown:

A week ago, Republicans were 27 points more likely than Democrats to consider the email issue "very serious." Now the Republicans are 52 points more likely to consider the matter "very serious" than Democrats.

Seventy-one percent of the Democrats said the media is making too big a deal out of the story. A majority of Republicans think the story isn't getting enough attention.

Independents, by 8 points, are more likely to say the media is overhyping the controversy than to say it's being underreported.

Are independents concerned? Thirty-four percent surveyed reported that use of a personal email account is very serious. But those independents are also not paying much attention, with 57 percent saying they're following the email story at least somewhat closely, compared to 78 percent of Republicans and 68 percent of Democrats.

SOME NEWS YOU MIGHT HAVE MISSED

The New York Times reported that Saudi Arabia has bestowed one of its highest honors on Dr. Zakir Naik, a Muslim televangelist who in the past expressed support for Osama bin Laden, called the United States the "biggest terrorist," and claimed the 9/11 attacks were ordered by President George W. Bush.

Dr. Naik appeared at a ceremony at a luxury hotel in Saudi Arabia where the nation's new monarch, King Salman, gave him the King Faisal International Prize for service to Islam. The televangelist, who is from India, also received a gold medal and a cash award of nearly \$200,000.

The Times said the award

"highlighted the conflicted position of Saudi Arabia as an American ally that continues to back Islamists who espouse hatred of the West."

Dr. Naik was trained as a physician but is now the founder and president of the Mumbai India-based Islamic Research Foundation and a televangelist on his TV channel, Peace TV. Years ago he said he supported Osama bin Laden if he was fighting the United States: "If he is terrorizing America the terrorist, the biggest terrorist, I am with him. Every Muslim should be a terrorist. The thing is that if he is terrorizing the terrorist, he is following Islam." He also referred to bin Laden as a "soldier of Islam."

Naik asserted that Muslims who convert from Islam and propagate another faith should be killed, and claimed that Jews control the United States.

"The Jews are less than 5 percent in America, but they are controlling the economy, they are controlling America," he said, and declared that Jews are the "strongest in enmity to Muslims."

During a lecture, Naik discussed the 9/11 attacks and said that by "the amount of ample evidence, a fool will know this is an inside job. It is a blatant, open secret that this attack on the twin towers was done by George Bush himself."

Also in 2013, he was named the Islamic Personality of the Year by a religious association in Dubai, an honor bestowed by the prime minister of the United Arab Emirates.

And in 2013, Dr. Naik received a Distinguished Personality award from Malaysia's Department of Islamic Development, presented by Malaysia's head of state.
